1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. C. Andrews who was unwell and N. Harvey who was on holiday.

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No declarations of interest were made.

3. PUBLIC FORUM

No contributions were made by members of the public.

4. PLANNING COMMITTEE REMIT

The Clerk reported that CPBC currently received in the region of 400 applications for planning consent per year for the Canvey Island area. The Town Council had a right to be consulted on all applications within its civil parish.

The Council had previously indicated that it did not wish to comment on every application submitted.

RECOMMEND that the Council's Planning Committee does not consider applications for planning consent which involve:

- i) alterations to or extensions of any existing residential dwelling;
- ii) advertising/signage.

The Chairman of the Planning Committee, in discussion with the Vice-Chairman and Town Clerk, may however, request that any application relevant to Canvey Island is considered by the Committee if it is considered to be of significant local interest.
