There are five award categories this year which are:

- Citizen of the Year (over 18 years)
- Community Group of the Year.
- Best School Community Project.
- Young Person of the Year (18 years or under)
- Best Community Contribution from a Local Business

Citizen of the Year

Cllr Acott presented the award to Joan Lythgoe in recognition of her work with Business Opportunities for the Physically Handicapped which she has been running since 1995.

Community Group of the Year

Cllr Acott presented the award to Canvey Island Community First Responders in recognition for their dedication and tireless efforts in giving up their own free time for the wellbeing of the community

Best School Community Project

Cllr Acott presented the award to Cornelius Vermuyden School in recognition for their work in setting up an ECO council and for the students who work tirelessly to improve the environment on Canvey Island and around the school

Young Person of the Year

Cllr Acott presented the award to Oliver Payne in recognition for his dedication at school to achieving a Bronze Eco Award and through hard work is striving towards achieving the Silver Award for the school.

Best Community Contribution from a Local Business

Cllr Acott presented the award to Morrison's in recognition for their charity work and support of the local community.

Cllr Acott explained that the Town Council had great difficulty in deciding the winners this year from those nominated as there were many worthy nominees. To close the meeting Cllr Acott congratulated all the award winners and thanked all the residents for attending and supporting the Town Council.
