**CANVEY LAKE**

- Issues with night fishing and anti-social behaviour call 101 and the home office code 116/11 for reporting 'Theft of Fishing' to help with the issues at the weekends.
- The 50 new trees at Canvey Lake were planted on the 29<sup>th</sup>/30<sup>th</sup>/31<sup>st</sup> March. We were given an extra 10 trees as they were not able to use them elsewhere and volunteers were not required in the end due to the machinery that was required.
- The leak at Vadseo Road has been stopped, however, Anglian Water insinuated that the Town Council should pay for a small amount of pipe work to be updated. A meeting took place between me, the Town Clerk and Anglian Water where it was confirmed that Town Council has no responsibility to maintain waste pipes. We are now waiting for them to advise when they will be carrying out the work.
- The EA and the local Wildlife Police Officer conducted a patrol of Canvey lake on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> March.
