Progress Report for All Open Spaces – 17/10/2022

CANVEY LAKE

- Issues with night fishing and anti-social behaviour call 101 and the home office code 116/11 for reporting 'Theft of Fishing' to help with the issues at the weekends.
- New vinyl stickers have been placed on existing 'Fishing Zone Signs' - 6 in total to advise of fishing ban.
- Issues with residents entering the lake, cutting reeds, and leaving the debris in pink sacks and on the banks.
- It is now not possible to monitor the bank erosion along the footpath from the fishing area, as it is not possible to see how far underneath this erosion goes.
- Vandalised and burnt picnic bench by play area.
