BROAD RANGE OF ACTIVITIES AND INNOVATIVE PROJECTS

Canvey Island Town Council conducts a broad range of activities and innovative projects which are as follows:

Ongoing Projects:

Management and maintenance of recreation areas such as the Labworth Memorial Gardens, Canvey Lake, Concord Beach Tidal Pool, Tewkes Creek Wildflower Meadow, and the Band Stand.

Management and maintenance of a children's Play Area.

Annual Community Events such as Armed Forces Day, Christmas Event, Charity Garden Trail, Wildlife Day, Fly a Flag, Community Lake Picnic, and a Summer Events programme for the school holidays.

Production of Quarterly Newsletters, Annual Report and Town Guide.

Grant Scheme with an annual budget of £5,000 - funding for 2020/21 went to Yellow Door and CAVS to assist with COVID-19 emergency funding requirements for food banks.

Planting and Maintaining Town Centre Hanging Baskets and various Planters around Canvey Island.

Community Awards scheme recognising local individuals and groups who had made a significant contribution to the quality of life for Canvey Island residents. The awards were established to recognise the efforts of those who work or live in Canvey Island and give up their own time, without any expectation or recognition, under the categories of Citizen of the year, Young Citizen of the Year, Youth Community Group of the year, Community Group of the year, Best Community Contribution from a Local Business and Best School Community Project.

Festive lighting and Christmas Trees in the Town Centre and Foksville Road.

The Council off is a Keep Safe Location, Dementia Friendling locations and a J9 Domestic Abuse location.
