## **Local Support**

Essex County Council set up Essex Wellbeing Service who can assist with food deliveries for the vulnerable. The contact number is 0300 3039988.

Locally there is The Yellow Door project on Canvey which does have a food bank and are very good at signposting where help is available. Contact number 01268 683431.

In Benfleet there is CAVS (Castle Point Association of Volunteers) who operate Ways to Wellness. They were previously arranging food deliveries so may still be doing this and they also run a befriending service, via the telephone, if having someone to talk to would help with feeling isolated.
