The Council has been fortunate to have been successful with many grant applications in 2024/25 such as MOD funding for Armed Forces Day of £939, Safer Streets funding for safety projects of £2,831, Canvey Big Local for grass cutting of £3,000 and Urban Tree funding for the final year of maintenance of 50 trees planted of £4,725. The Council has increased its allotments rents and received its first payment of CIL funding in this financial year. The miscellaneous income shows a significant refund for the over payment of water charges over a period of time of £2,747, an insurance payment to cover the costs for damage caused to its office from a water leak in an adjacent property of £290, a refund of grant funding provided in 2023/24 to the RBL of £475 and the sale of its office blinds of £200.
