	<p>Labworth Café, Eastern Esplanade, Canvey Island, SS8 7DW</p> <p>Installed October 2019.</p>	<p>Celebrating the history of the Labworth building and it's designer. The building was built in 1932-33 by Ove Arup to resemble the bridge of the Queen Mary and it exists as the only building solely designed by the distinguished designer</p>

	<p>Canvey Island Library, High Street, SS8 7RB</p> <p>Installed February 2013.</p>	<p>This plaque commemorates the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the 1953 Flood and the islanders who lost their lives.</p>
	<p>Labworth Memorial Gardens, Furtherwick Rd, SS8 7DW</p> <p>Installed March 2014.</p>	<p>In Memory of Vincent Heatherson, 1979 – 2012. Campaigner for the first Canvey Island 1953 Flood Victim Memorial and a chairman of the Canvey 2000 seafront development. Designer of the gardens.</p>
