



	<p>Winter Gardens Baptist Church, Hilton Rd, SS8 9QA</p> <p>Installed in June 2009.</p>	<p>Former location of the Winter Gardens Palace and the Mono Railway. Designed and Built by Frederick Hester 1853 – 1943 and his son F.W.B Hester 1876 - 1911</p>
	<p>Labworth Café, Eastern Esplanade, Canvey Island, SS8 7DW</p> <p>Installed October 2019.</p>	<p>Celebrating the history of the Labworth building and its designer. Labworth Café - built in 1932-33 by Ove Arup 1895 – 1988 to resemble the bridge of the Queen Mary.</p> <p>It exists as the only building solely designed by the distinguished designer</p>
	<p>Friends of Concord Beach Hut, Eastern Esplanade, Canvey Island, SS8 7DW</p> <p>Installed March 2022</p>	<p>Commemorating the life of Ada. E. Andrews.</p> <p>1904 - 1983 - a tribute to a devoted volunteer nurse of St John Ambulance who dedicated her life to saving others. Honoured to inspire future generations.</p>

	<p>Canvey Island Heritage Centre &amp; Museum, 22A Canvey Road, Canvey Island, SS8 0LW</p> <p>Installed August 2022</p>	<p>Commemorating the life and work of Clara Grace James.</p> <p>1866 – 1954 – Councillor and Justice of the Peace. Founder of Canvey's Labour Party and Women's Institute.</p> <p>This dedication is one of many proposed by an initiative and committee set up by the Lord Lieutenant of Essex, Jennifer Tolhurst, to commemorate the achievements of women across the county.</p>
