NIGHT SAFETY PROJECT

The Town Council has successfully obtained funding from the Essex Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner's Road Safety Fund for a night safety project aimed at cyclists, runners, dog walkers and other pavement users during the darker hours.

The funding will be used to purchase cycle safety lights, reflective arm bands and LED keyrings to help improve visibility for both the pavement user and drivers. The Town Council will be distributing items at community engagement events in partnership with Castle Point Community Policing Team and Safer Essex Roads Partnership.
