FLY TIPPING

At the beginning of March the maintenance team found evidence of fly tipping left at the bins by Denham Road. The resident who lives in Thisselt Road has been contacted with the photos of the evidence found.

Wild Fowl/Grass

The Council are trying out new ideas regarding the grass cutting. It will leave the grass areas between Denham Road and the Oysterfleet for a month to allow the geese to feed and to see if this has an impact on the geese moving into neighbouring roads.

The Jetty

The jetty has been restored, with new rails and all new bolts.

Biodiversity Management plan

Our Biodiversity management plan is well under way. Part of this process is to leave parts of the grass banks to grow longer which will encourage more insects and will not only benefit the geese, but will stop their droppings falling back in to the water causing toxins.

There will be no 'quick fix' at Canvey Lake but the council is dedicated to making sure it accomplishes the right result by using all the official organisations around us.



MEMORIAL GARDEN

The memorial garden has had new fences around the perimeter, there are two new bee posts and the area around the base has been left to grow which may look unkempt but has been left to attract more bees and wildlife.

The Covid Memorial Garden has now had all the summer plants planted.

ALLOTMENTS

The Town Council own two allotment sites at Smallgains and Winter Gardens. Since Covid the waiting list is extremely large due to the amount of residents wanting to grow their own fruit and vegetables.
