Canvey Island Southern Shoreline Revetment Replacement Project: Site compound set-up



What are we telling you about?

We are writing to inform you that on the 3 January we will begin to set up the main and relevant satellite compounds. These compounds are required to deliver the first phase of the Canvey Island Southern Shoreline Revetment Replacement Scheme.

Where is this happening?

Our contractors will begin to set up the following compound locations shown on the accompanying plan:

- Main compound end of Eastern Esplanade / south of Athol Close
- Material storage compound Thorney Bay Road
- Satellite compound 1 Western Esplanade

When is this happening?

This work will begin from Tuesday 3 January 2023. We expect the material storage compound to be ready by February. The main compound and satellite compound 1 will be ready by late March. These works will take place between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday in line with the relevant conditions of our July 2022 planning application approvals. We will not begin work on the tidal defences until late March 2023, and we will provide further information ahead of that date.

What is the impact of the work?

Our contractors will be on the Island until the summer of 2025. We have planned the compounds' design and construction to minimise the impact on the community as much as possible:

- downward lighting away from residential properties & partly shielded by the high-quality perimeter hoardings
- · carrying out regular noise monitoring
- restricting plant deliveries and movements to daytime hours wherever possible

- restricting the speed of heavy vehicles on local roads to minimise vibration
- switching off plant, equipment and vehicles when they are not in use for long periods of time

We will keep residents fully informed via newsletters, site notices and through a dedicated representative on site to answer queries or address any concerns.

Why are we doing this?

The main welfare, site offices and principal material storage will be within the main compound. The main compound will act as the hub and provide necessary facility requirements based on the number of operatives, nature of the works and duration for the scheme. In addition, the main compound will need to allow for some concrete works areas for both proposed concrete works and general prefabrication works.
